I am contacting you through the University Hospitals Bristol public and patient engagement lead, as you have previously expressed an interest in patient and public involvement activities taking place at the Trust.

My name is Helen Ireland, and I am pharmacist within the Bristol Royal Infirmary. I am currently undertaking a part time educational doctorate at the University of Leeds, exploring what is understood by professionalism and how professionalism is taught and assessed across the pre-registration pharmacist placement. The focus group will take place at the University Hospitals Bristol Education and Research Centre on ONE of the following dates/times:


- Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May in the afternoon
