
Patient Pain Forum Would you like to help develop future services for people experiencing long-term pain?

What is the Patient Pain Forum?

We are looking for volunteer patients aged 18 years and over. Have you been seen by local pain services within the last 2 years? If so, you could become involved in the work of the Integrated Pain Management team (IPM) via our forum.

We are planning to hold an initial patient event on the afternoon of Thursday 14th July 2016 at The Vassall Centre, Bristol. We will explain about the role of the IPM. We are also looking for your views about short, medium and long term aims for the improvement of pain services.

The forum events will be open for anyone to attend. We will be able to reimburse your travel expenses, but please be aware that you will need to be able to make your travel arrangements. If you need to bring a carer with you, then we can pay for their expenses.

If the initial event is successful, we hope to develop the forum into more regular meetings to discuss some of the detailed research and education projects that the IPM has planned. At this point, we will be able to pay you for your involvement (approximately £20 per meeting plus travel expenses). You do not need to commit to anything at this stage.

How can I get involved?

If you are interested in taking part in the work of the IPM through a Patient Pain Forum, then we would like to hear from you.

It is an ideal opportunity for you to let us know what topics are important to you. It also gives you the chance to make your voice heard alongside a team of professionals who would like to improve current pain services.
