Using 'Partneropoly' to broaden engagement with patients and the public.

Partneropoly is a game played on a room-sized textile quilt, where the players are the pieces who walk around the squares. The aim is to support partnership working and players are challenged to come up with new ideas for collaboration as they move. The game has been used by different groups by Bristol Health Partners. Hildegard Dumper from the People in Health West of England team has played the game at several events with about 30 members of the public with great success.

Partneropoly is the brain child of Jan Connett, Senior Project Manager at Bristol Health Partners. She said:

"It's fantastic to see Partneropoly taking on a life of its own. It's been played by many people from different organisations during the past six months or so, and each time participants have wanted to take the game to a new group of people. People can really see the benefit of using Partneropoly to explore collaborations in new and exciting ways."
